## **Exemptions to Shared Responsibility Payment**

Types of Coverage Exemptions are in the Resource Guide 4012 pg H-14

These we're familiar with, some are easy:

- Household income below filing threshold
- Short coverage gap
- Medicare non-expansion state: 138% of federal poverty level 4012 pg H-21
- Member of a Native American tribe
- Member of a health care sharing ministry
- Others

## Affordability Exemption

Two situations occur: Employer offers health insurance, and

Employer does not offer health insurance

Let's look at both

Employer offers health insurance (self-only, family, or multiple self-onlys)

Let's look at the Meadows again AGI \$46,748 household income \$54,293

The Meadows did not take the offered insurance from Lois' employer \$5000 payment

The Meadow's affordability threshold is 8.05% of their income 4012 pg H-15

 $0.0805 \times 46,748 = 3,763$  \$5000 is greater

The Meadows have an affordability exemption Code A

No Employer health insurance offer

Can the Meadows afford Marketplace insurance?

Marketplace Affordability Worksheet see 4012 pg H-17 HANDOUT

Need the lowest cost Bronze (Line 1) and Second lowest cost Silver (Line 10)

From YourHealthIdaho.org

Let's fill out the worksheet

Lowest cost Bronze \$1100

Second lowest cost Silver \$1183, why? Warren qualifies for CHIPs

The Meadow's eligible coverage would cost them \$3636

What's the Meadow's affordability limit? \$4371

The Meadows do not qualify for the Affordability Exemption They must pay SRP

Listed at the bottom of the Exemptions page

To qualify for any of these you used to have to complete a Hardship Exemption Application

Show the Hardship Exemption Application from last year

Now we simply enter Code G and away we go

Draft 8965 Instructions show the Types of Coverage Exemptions

Code G is General Hardship

Hardships are currently listed at the bottom of the Exemptions table 4012 pg H-15 I'm sure that the 4012 will be updated too.
