

Transcript of Prior Year Tax Returns and W-2s from the IRS

Frequently ask questions about getting past tax returns.

W-2 Transcript:

- To view and print a computer transcript of your Form W-2 information as well as other transcripts at no charge, use the 'Get Transcript' tool on the IRS website and request a "Wage & Income Transcript."
- If you are unable to receive your Form W-2 transcript using the online tool, mail or fax Form 4506-T, *Request for Transcript of Tax Return*, or call 800-908-9946. Expect to receive your Wage & Income transcript within 5 to 10 days from the time we receive your request.
- The IRS can provide Form W-2 information for up to 10 years.
- Current year information is generally not available until the year after it is filed with the IRS. For example, Form W-2 information for 2013 filed in 2014, may not be available from the IRS until 2015.
- Please note that a Wage & Income transcript only includes federal information; it does not include state or local information.
