

FORM 1040-ES ESTIMATED VOUCHER

Form 1040-ES has a long worksheet that is nice if the taxpayer is anticipating several income, dependent, etc. changes during the next tax year.

Most taxpayers will probably know how much more taxes to pay using 1040-ES so an easy shortcut is to insert the number on Line 16 at "Estimate desired, if different from required". For example if \$4000 is entered the program will provide four vouchers each with \$1000 payments.

If the taxpayer wants vouchers with the amount of payment blank, go to each voucher, override (F8) each amount and delete whatever is in the blank before printing.

These overrides will not change any other data in the tax return so messing around here should be OK
